

Resolution of the Executive Committee, Edinburgh, United Kingdom 5-9 October 1981

"EPO Documentation"

FICPI, the International Federation of Intellectual Property Attorneys, broadly representative of the free profession throughout the world, assembled at its Executive Committee and World Congress held in Edinburgh, United Kingdom, 5-9 October 1981, passed the following resolution:

FICPI **strongly supports** the position that the dissemination of technical knowledge shall remain a function of National Patent Offices. For implementing that object, FICPI **requests** the European Patent Office to support the documentation centres of the National Patent Offices and give them access to the computerized technical information available in the European Patent Office.
