

Resolution of the Executive Committee, Vienna, Austria, 10-14 October 1983

"Centenary of the Paris Convention of 1883"

FICPI, the International Federation of Intellectual Property Attorneys, broadly representative of the free profession throughout the world, assembled at its Executive Committee held in Vienna, Austria, 10-14 October 1983, passed the following Resolution:

On the occasion of the Centenary of the Paris Convention of 1883,

Considering the extraordinary merit of Dr. Arpad Bogsch, Director of the World Intellectual Property Organisation WIPO, in the maintenance and progressive balanced development of the Paris Convention and in general in the defence of Industrial Property Rights,

Resolves to render homage to Dr. Arpad Bogsch and to express its appreciation for his untiring dedication and achievements in the defence of Industrial Property Rights and for his inspiring and prolific professional activity, in particular as Director of the World Intellectual Property Organisation (WIPO).
