## **Resolution of the Executive Committee 19 May 2021**

## "The Protection of Partial Designs"

**FICPI**, the International Federation of Intellectual Property Attorneys, broadly representative of the free profession throughout the world, assembled online for a meeting of its Executive Committee held on 19 May 2021, passed the following resolution:

**NOTING** that novelty may reside in a design applied to a portion of an article (referred to as a "partial design");

**OBSERVING** that only some jurisdictions provide for the protection of partial designs;

**RECOGNISING** that some of these jurisdictions require that a partial design be part of a complex and/or larger product;

**BELIEVING** that partial designs are deserving of protection and should be protectable when represented as a standalone design, or as part of a complex and/or larger product;

**FURTHER BELIEVING** there should not be any requirement for the portion of an article embodying a partial design to be manufactured separately from the remainder of the article;

**URGES** all jurisdictions to provide for the protection of partial designs;

**FURTHER URGES** that such provision should not require:

- a) the entire article including the partial design to be represented; or
- b) that a partial design be part of a complex and/or larger product; or
- that the portion of an article embodying the partial design be manufactured separately from the remainder of the article.
